





(Boundaries by Council District)








What Do Respondents Say About Priorities

The areas that were most selected as the primary reasons why respondents choose to live in Sioux Falls also have the largest impact on whether they will stay in the City over the next 5 years

Access to public transportation, and secondary educational opportunities were selected least by respondents






Most Respondents Believe the Quality of Life in the City is Consistent

Most (94%) respondents indicated they think they will be living in Sioux Falls 5 years from now and 65% believe that the overall quality of life in the City is staying the same or getting better.


Do you think the overall quality of life in the City is getting better, staying the same, or getting worse?

Addressing the accessibility of housing was selected by almost 1 in 4 respondents





If you were interested in purchasing or renting a new home, what would be your three biggest obstacles to purchasing or renting a home today?






New Home Preference

Satisfaction with Residential Development


by percentage of respondents (excluding don't know responses)

by the sum percentage of respondents top three choices







Retail businesses (28%)






Favorite Building or Site Developed in Past 5 Years



Satisfaction with Commercial Development


