### PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE

The Sioux Falls Police Department offers a “Drug Take Back” program. This program allows citizens to drop off unused medications in a locked container in the lobby of the Law Enforcement Center from 6 a.m.–10 p.m.

#### Why should I properly dispose of medical waste?

An improperly disposed pharmaceutical waste can be a serious problem if flushed down the drain. Pharmaceuticals can accumulate in water systems and contaminate water supplies potentially affecting the natural hormones and development of wildlife.
